A great short hike, 3 miles round trip, is [Grotto Falls](#) off Roaring Fork Motor Nature Trail. A moderate trail, there are some roots and rocks with a slight incline to the 25 foot tall waterfall that you can walk behind. Be careful because the wet rocks can be slippery. Grotto Falls is also a great place to hunt for salamanders hiding under the stones in the cool stream. A wonderful way to spend the morning or afternoon and the trail head is just about a 15 minute ride from Johnson's Inn and Mountain Village Inn Condominiums.
